## Objectives

- Risk management is primarily a risk management planning tool, whether it is risk assessment, risk outcomes, and what is the expected risk, whether from the work or the worker. It is based on a coordinated and planned process in which risks are learned and their potential and are divided into a number of steps and tasks.

- Identifying potential or expected sources of work
- Clarify who can be exposed to any kind of risk
- Evaluate and evaluate the actions and precautions taken and appropriate in the specific area of work
- Write down the results and keep them for reference
- Review and evaluate at specific time intervals, organization and comparison

### DAY 5

- Risk
- Is the possibility of causing damage or injury to the worker, whether due to the behavior of the worker or the reason of the work or the result of the work done by him or the work done by him, as well as any danger arising from the machines and tools of the work of machines and tools and lifting tools and vehicles and means of movement and circulation and movement and any risk arising from the work Construction, construction, excavation and risk of collapse and fall. - The number of people who can take a risk
- The severity and severity of the injury or injury that the patient may suffer
- Probability of risk
